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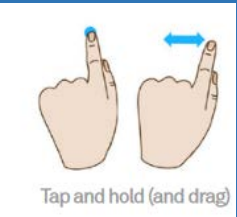


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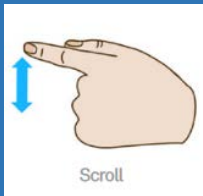
Android & IOS



Tap is a quick touch of the screen with one finger



Touch part of the screen keeping finger in contact with the screen (with Drag)



Scroll by a touch of the screen that doesn't have a button or link keeping finger in contact and moving up or down, right or left



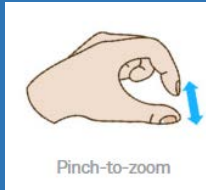
Swipe is a quick slash across the screen in either direction for flipping between pages or images

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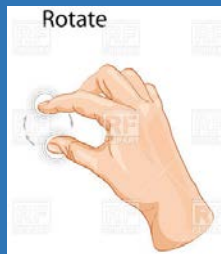
Android & IOS



Pinch to Zoom requires two fingers to zoom in or out of the screen



Double Tap is to tap part of the screen twice in quick succession. Similar to pinch to zoom.



Rotate with two fingers on the screen and a twist movement



2 and 3 Finger Tap/Scroll

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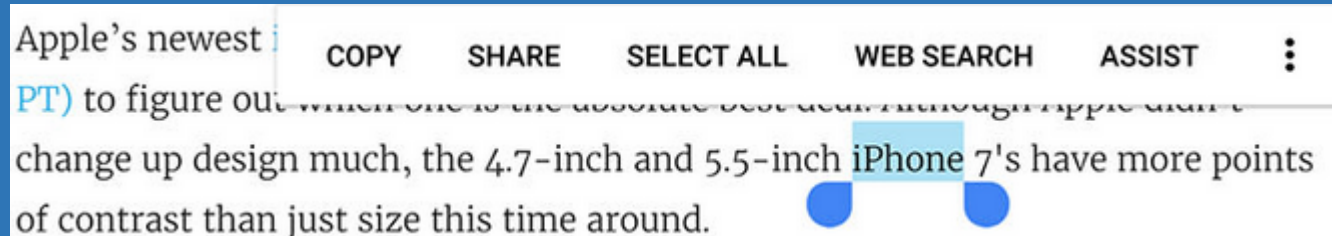


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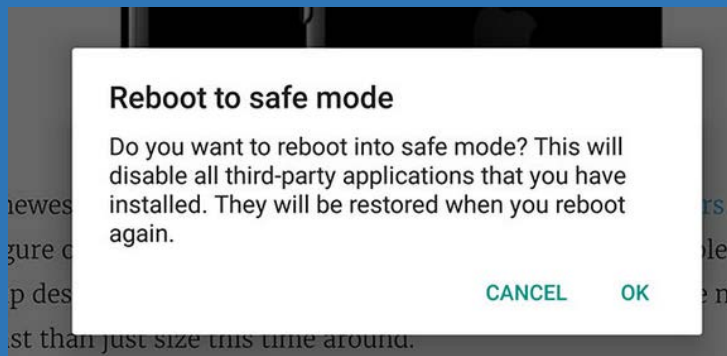
Android - Little Known



Two finger swipe down from top of screen to access Quick Settings pane



Press and Hold to Select (sometime double tap) - somewhere on screen to select a word. Then drag out handles to select more words



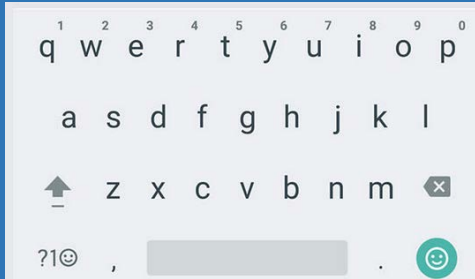
Safe Mode (to fix trouble apps) - Press & Hold the power button then Press & Hold the power off pop-up to get the Safe Mode option

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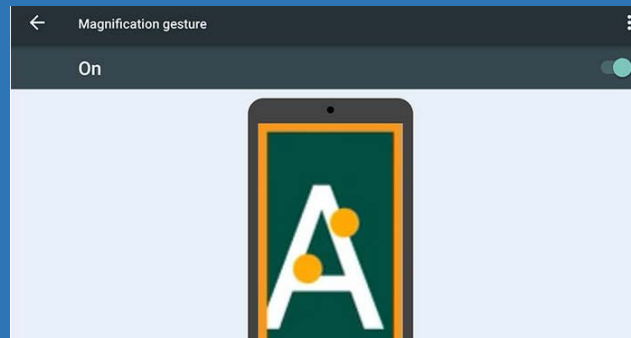


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Android - Little Known



To move the Cursor in Edit Text mode - Tap & Hold the spacebar then move finger left or right



Triple Tap to Zoom In e.g. for websites.
This needs enabling in OS settings to use



Want to Create your Own gesture i.e. draw an S on the screen to launch Settings.
There are a few apps to choose from for the job,
including All In One Gestures, Gesture Shortcuts or Finger Gesture Launcher.

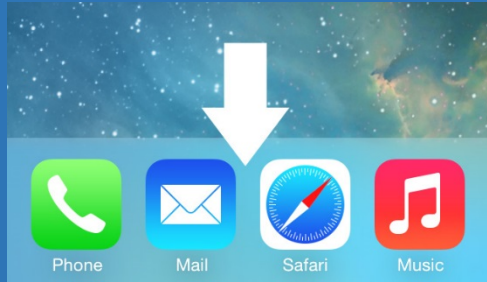
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Apple IOS - Little Known

Quick Return to Lock Screen - use one finger to swipe down from top of screen.



Double tap the home button to see all open apps.
These can then be closed by swiping the app up



To get to a quick search, Swipe 4/5 fingers down from the top of the screen

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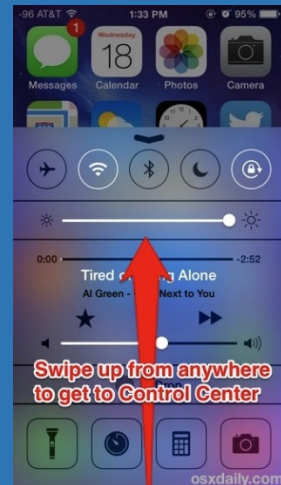


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Apple IOS - Little Known



A quick navigation back to the Home screen can be done by pinching with four fingers



Swipe up from bottom of the screen for the Control Panel.
(may also be the open apps screen)



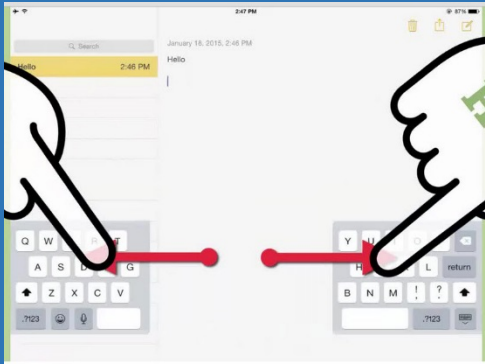
In typing mode, quick access to Capital, special characters or numbers by tapping on shift key then sliding finger to a key to get a capital, hold for Special Character. Tap on a top keyboard row and hold to toggle for a number

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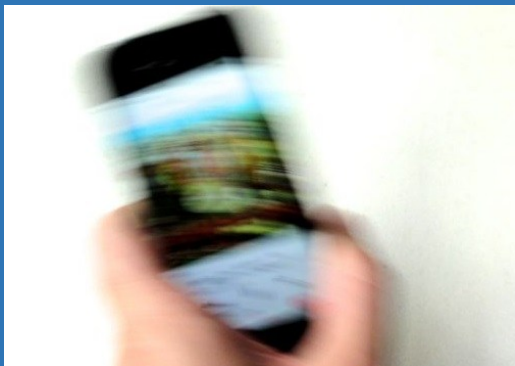
Apple IOS - Little Known



Want to split the keyboard for two handed typing. Tap, Hold & Drag the keyboard apart



Want to grab a copy of your screen and save as an image, hold the power button down & tap on the home button. Image then appears in your Camera Roll



Want to Undo what you've just typed then just shake the iPhone or iPad to get a pop-up confirmation. You may need to change option in....
Settings > General > Accessibility.

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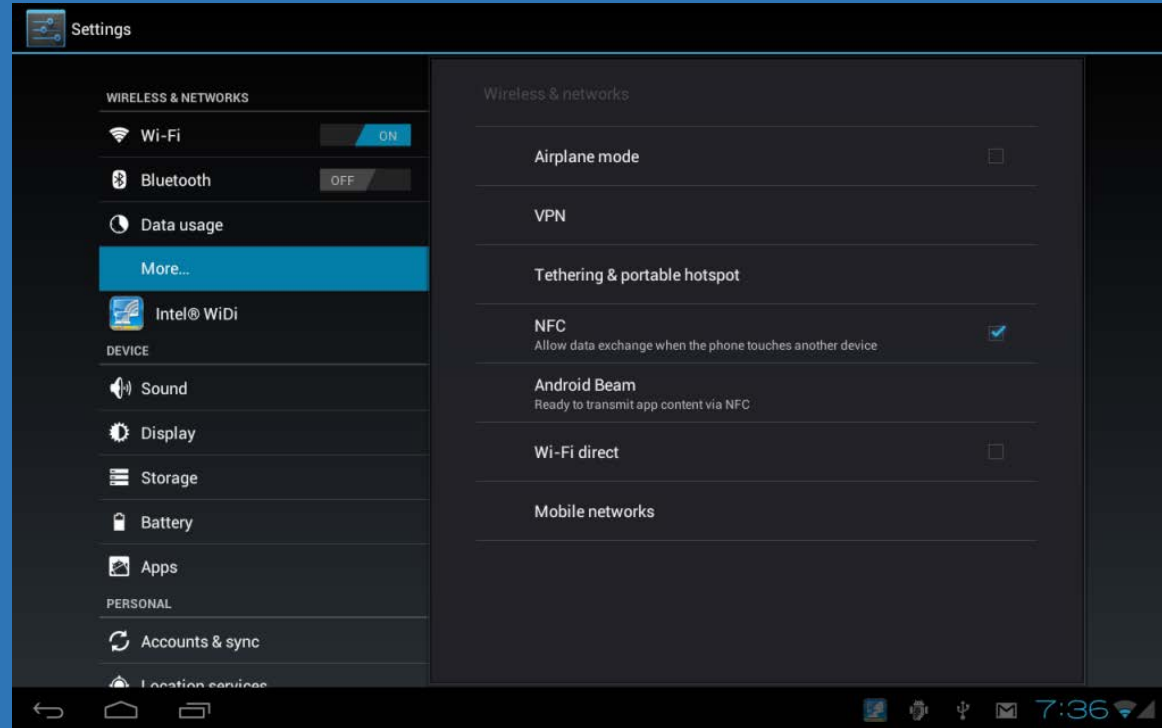
