The two photos are "Evening Spars" and HMS Alliance Interior. I took these photos on a recent trip to Portsmouth, where we stayed at the Premier Inn adjacent to the Historic dockyard.

1. Evening Spars

This photo was taken in the evening when there was a lovely sunset behind the "HMS Warrior", but the foreground was terrible.

However on examining the photo closely I found that the centre of the photo could be cropped to give an appealing final photo.



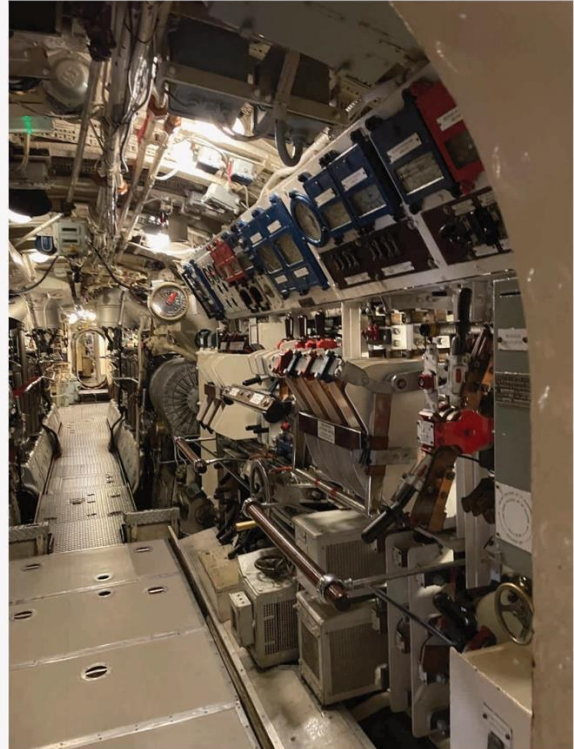
So, look for the crop that gives a pleasing photo
