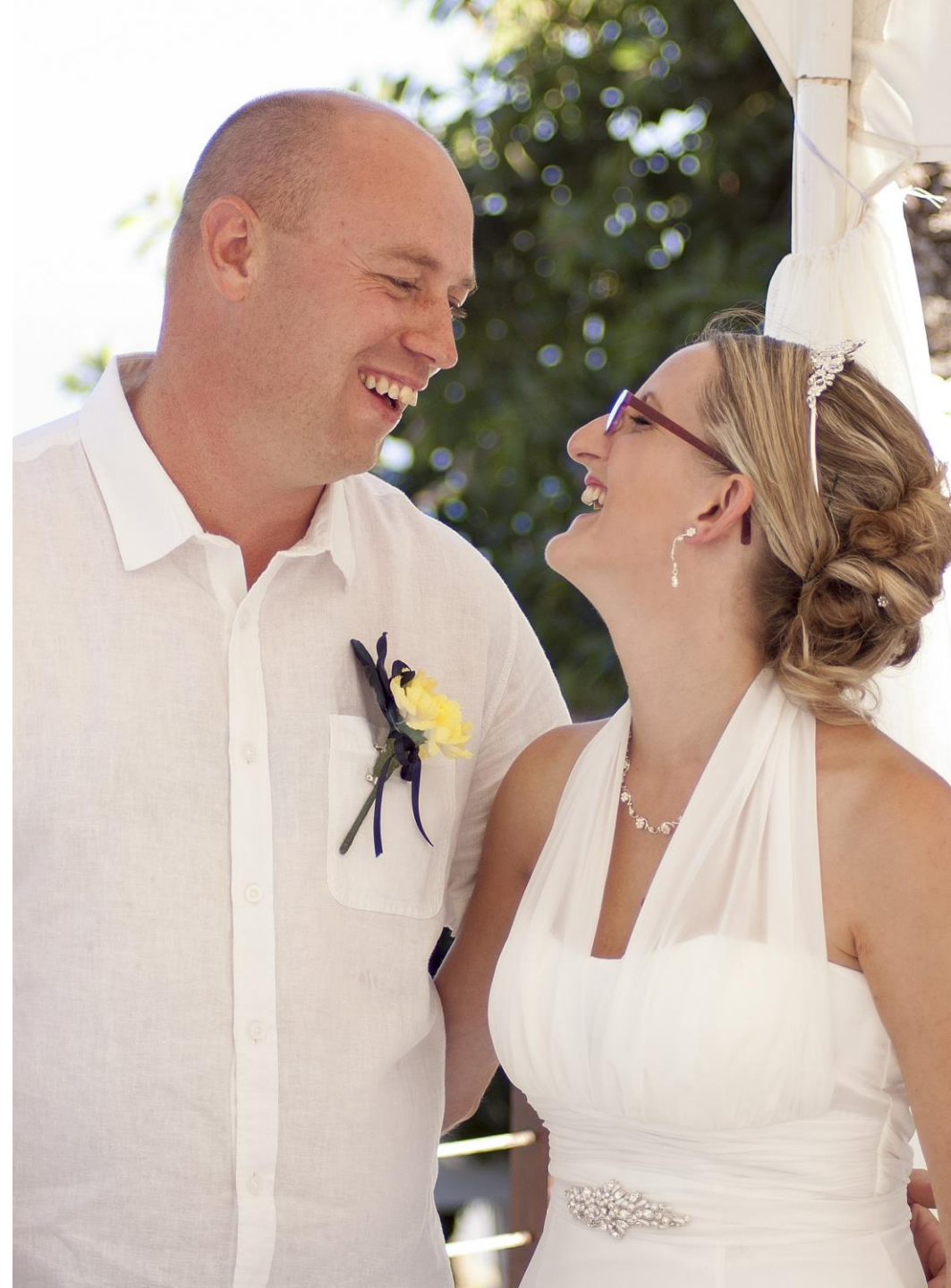

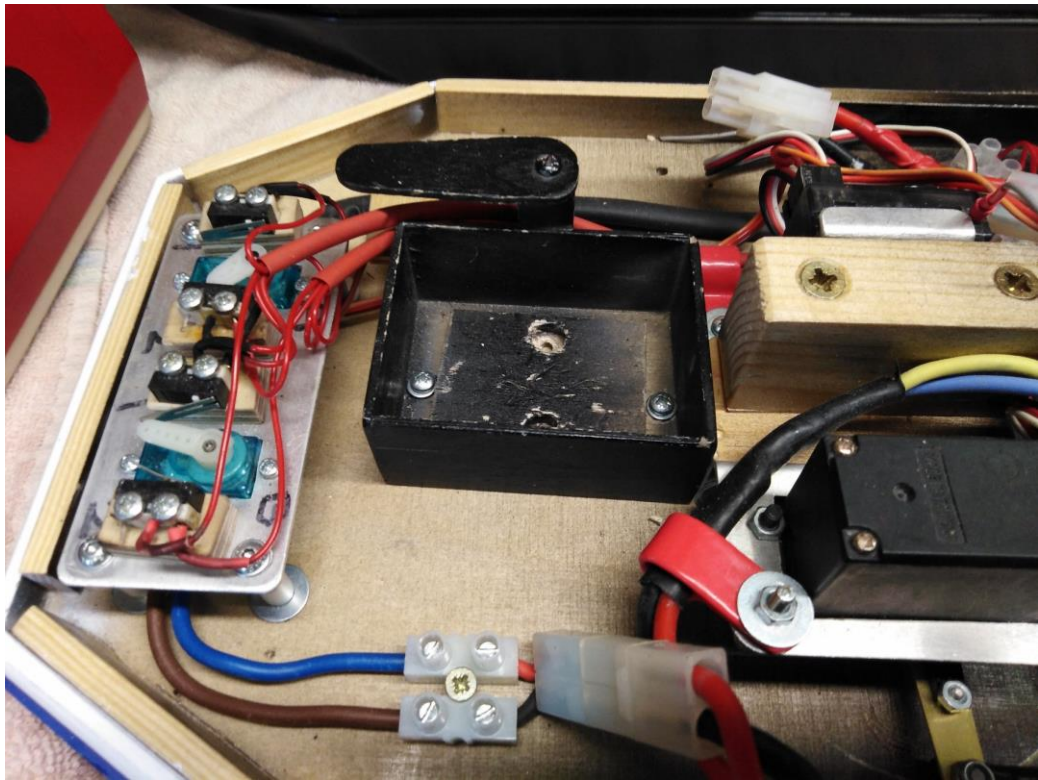
Documentary or Descriptive pictures
