Royalty & Copyright

Music royalties are compensatory payments received by rights holders (songwriters, composers, recording artists, and their respective representatives) in exchange for the licensed use of their music.

Copyright is a 'property' right. This means that the owner of the right, who can be the author or any person to whom the author has assigned it, has the exclusive right to authorise or prevent others from using their work in various ways. A 'musical work' consists entirely of music.

The words (or lyrics) of a song are a 'literary work'. Both are protected in the same way. Copyright in a musical or literary work lasts for 70 years after the end of the year in which the author dies. The musical work then becomes public property or 'public domain'.





Royalty Free & Copyright Free

Royalty-free refers to the licensing agreement between the content creator and the user. It means that you can use a piece of content multiple times without paying royalties or additional fees. However, it's important to note that royalty-free does not always mean that the content is **free** or in the public domain

Copyright-free is a term that's often used incorrectly. In reality, it refers to works that are in the public domain, meaning they are not protected by copyright. These works can be used freely without seeking permission or facing any legal repercussions.

Works labeled as 'copyright free' refer to works that are not protected by copyright and can be used freely without permission or payment.





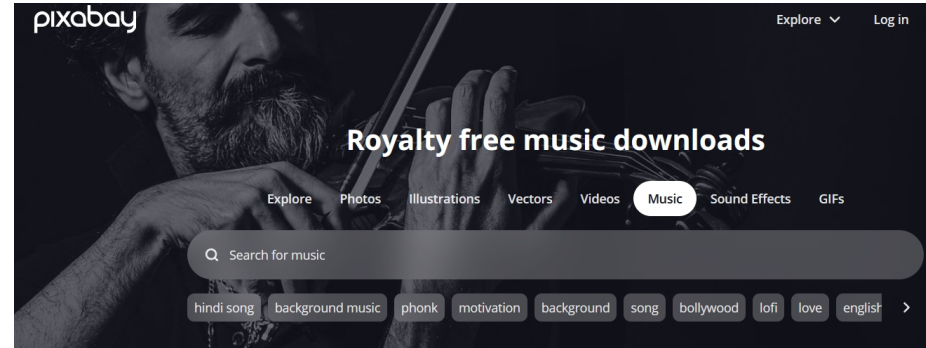

- or use browser extensions like Video DownloadHelper can grab the track



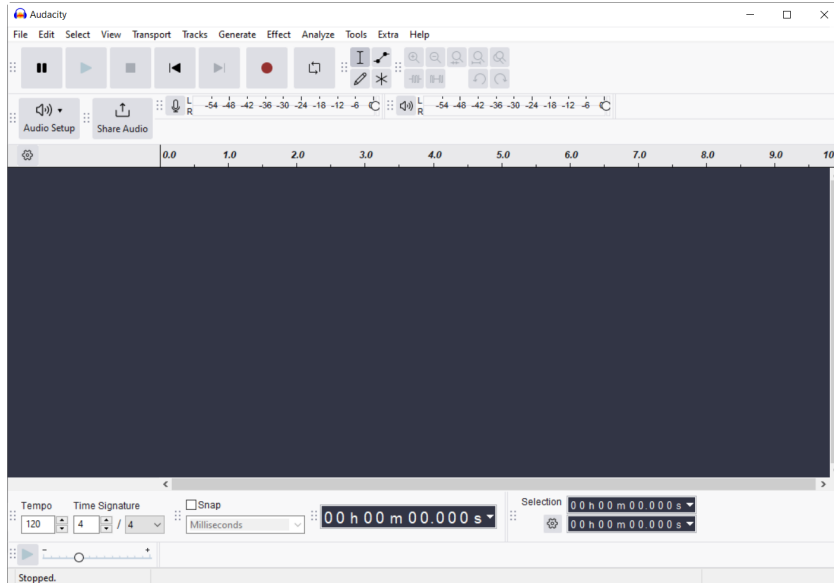


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Once you have some music tracks, you may need to compile a Mix to get the right length of music you want or in the order you want.

To do this use, you can use the free Audacity application **02** <https://www.audacityteam.org/>

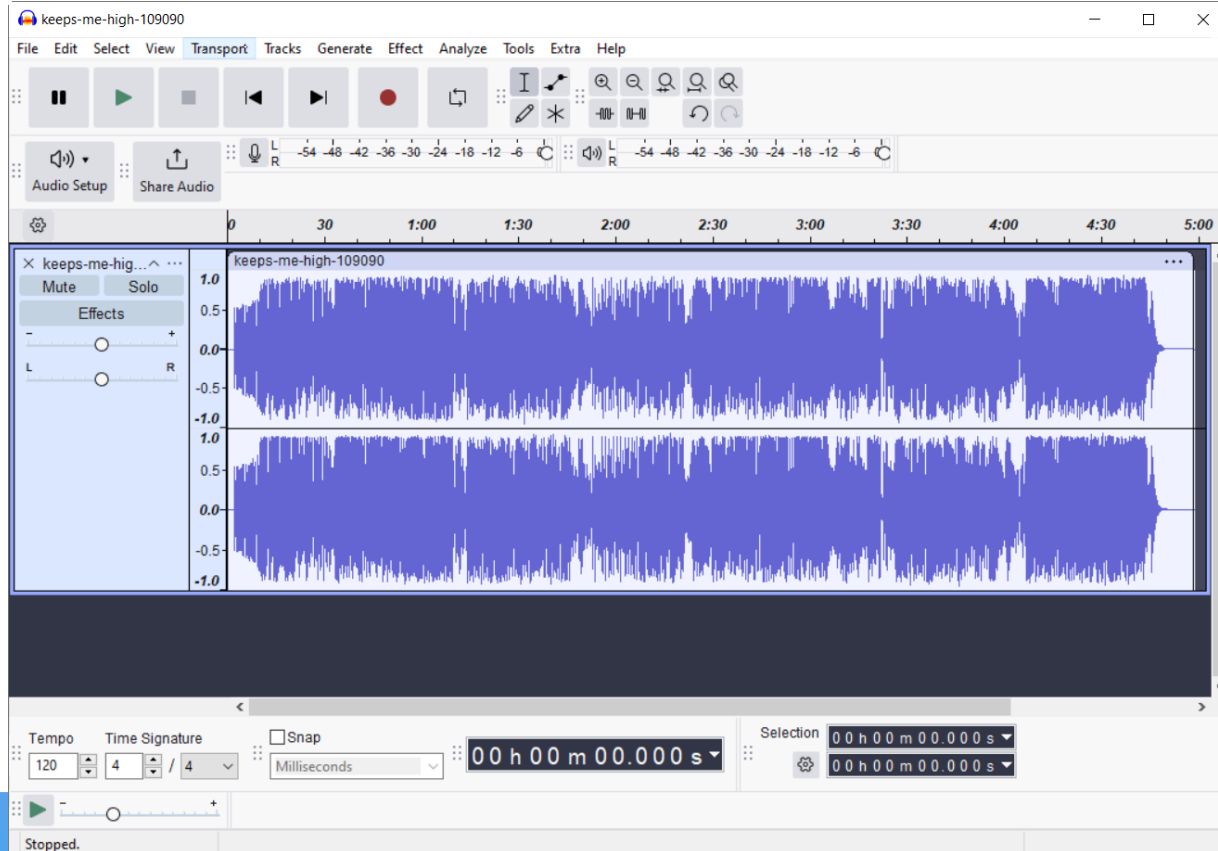




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You then drag the .mp3 music track into editing area

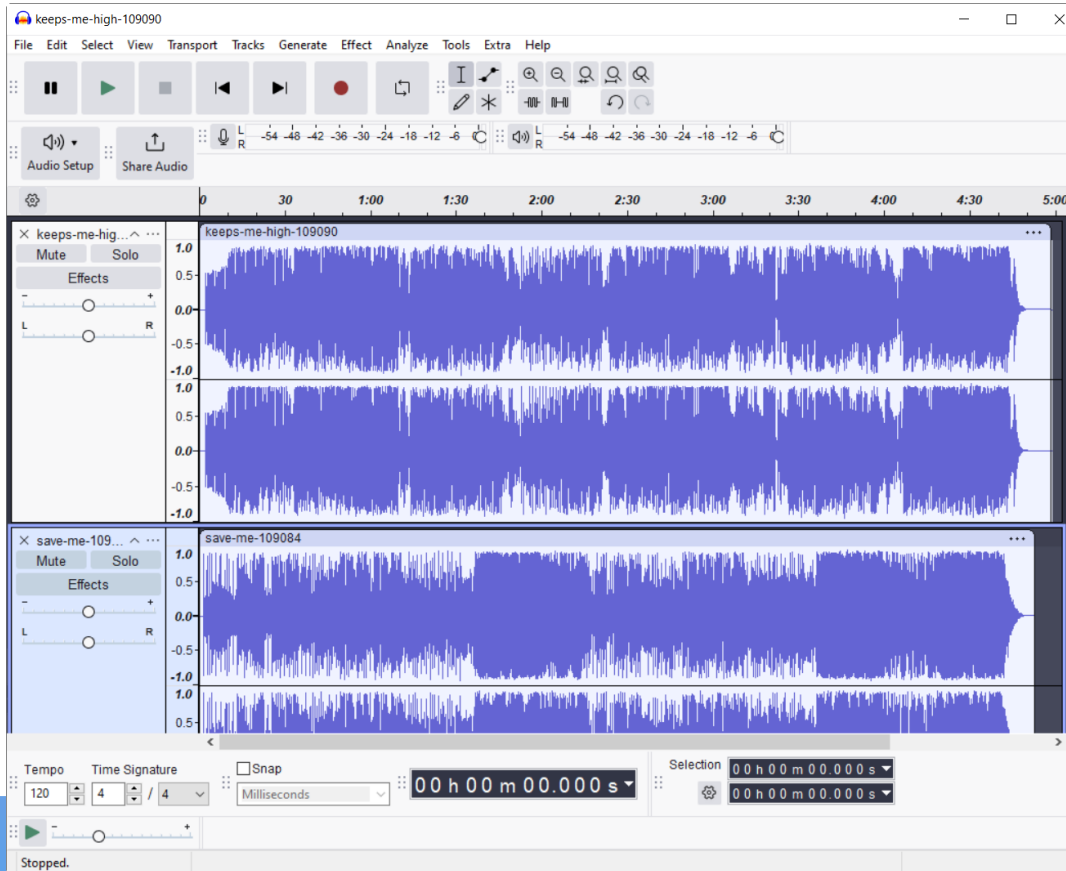




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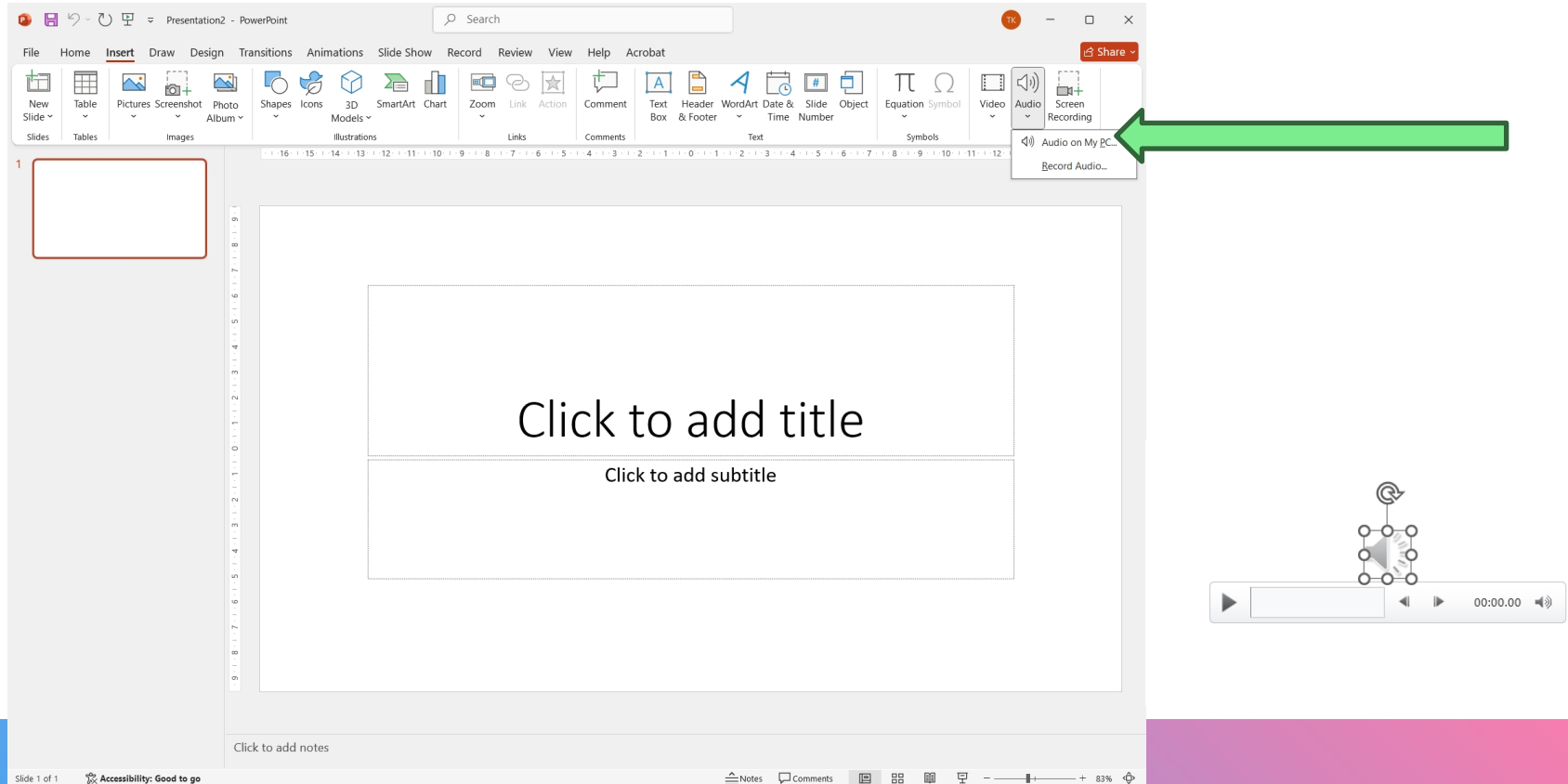


If you have 2 or more tracks to mix then drag both into editing area
