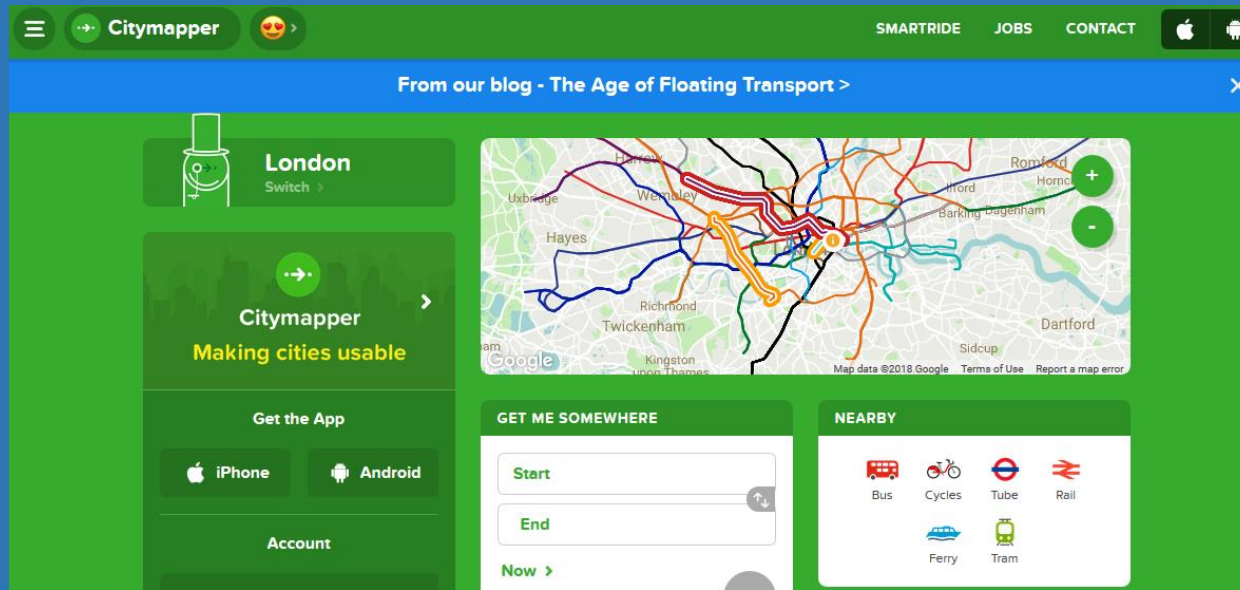

The most useful public transit app and mapping service around

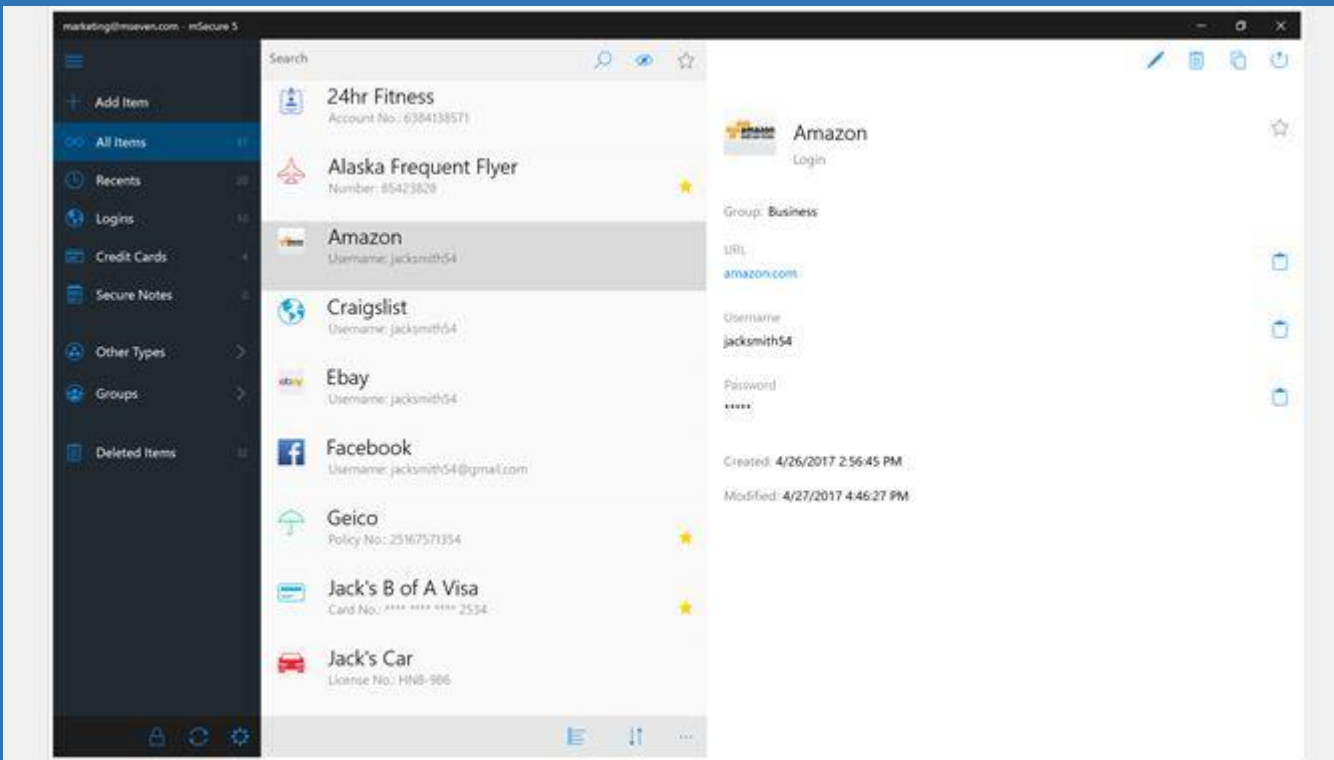
The "Get me Somewhere" is it's best feature providing journey planning options on routes & transport methods.

Spotify is a music streaming service that launched on 7 October 2008. It provides DRM-protected content from record labels and media companies. Spotify is a freemium service; basic features are free with advertisements (one or two every half an hour of music). Available free for most modern devices iOS, and Android smartphones and tablets. Spotify provides access to more than 35 million songs/music. Music can be browsed through or searched for by parameters such as artist, album, genre, playlist, or record label so you can create your own playlist.
